Day 1: Arrive Kigali, Rwanda

On arrival, we'll meet you at Kigali International Airport and transfer you to your accommodation. Settle in and relax before meeting your fellow travellers at dinner. Tonight we will discuss and prepare for the adventure that awaits.

Day 2: Goma, DR Congo

Today is an early start as we wind our way through the "Kingdom of a thousand hills" to the bustling town of Goma, the capital of the North Kivu province in the eastern D.R.C After lunch at a local restaurant, we will experience the real Goma on a local city tour. Learn to ride a Tshukudu (a local Congolese bike), taste the local chocolate and coffee of this region. Finish with a beer and cheese-tasting experience while learning about the famous wooden masks of Congo.

Day 3: Virunga National Park

After meeting our Virunga National Park vehicles and escort we will make our way to Mikeno Lodge, set high up in the Virunga Mountain Range close enough to Mt Nyiragongo volcano to be able to catch a glimpse of it glowing at night. On the way we will pass through local villages and travel alongside the lava path from the 2002 eruption. Once at Mikeno Lodge we will visit the Congo Hounds antipoaching unit and Senkwekwe Gorilla Orphanage. After dinner relax around the open fire and learn more about the history of Virunga National Park and this incredible region.

Day 4: Mountain Gorilla Trek

Today we set off to Bukima base camp for our gorilla trek into the Virunga National Park home to six habituated gorilla families that move between neighbouring Bwindi Forest and Magahinga National parks in Uganda. Nothing matches the feeling of seeing these incredible creatures under the shadow of the magnificent Virunga Mountain range. It's simply awesome.

Days 5: Optional Volcano Trek & Widows Sewing Group

This morning we will visit Virunga National Park's sewing group. 'The Widows Sewing Workshop' was created to help widows of fallen rangers regain a sense of control over their lives. We will then make our way back to Goma, unless you are more adventurous and have opted to trek the mighty Nyiragongo volcano. Instead of heading back to Goma you will be transferred to Kibati ranger station where you will begin the five-hour trek to the crater rim. You will then stay overnight in wonderfully appointed cabins that look down into the fiery depths below! Tonight will be an experience like no other!

Days 6: Gorilla Doctors/return from Volcano trek

For those staying in Goma this is a chance to spend a relaxing morning on the shores of Lake Kivu. After lunch we will join those travellers coming back from their volcano experience and head to the DRC headquaters of Gorilla Doctors to understand more about their incredible work to help save the rare mountain gorilla.

Days 7: Tchegera Island

Today we will visit beautiful Tchegera Island, located offshore in Lake Kivu. We will cross the lake by speedboat and enjoy a BBQ lunch on the beach. There are Kyaks avalable if you would like to explore the island by water or even just take a swim and chill out on the beach with a wine or two.

Day 8: Goodbye Land of the Gorillas, Return to Kigali

This morning we will cross back into Rwanda with unforgettable memories of DRC. We will return to Kigali in time for any flights departing after 3pm.

Alternatively stay an extra night and explore the history and culture of Rwanda's capital or venture further into the Congo with RAW Africa's Kahuzi Biega adventure.
